# How do I inject the Pre-filled Pen?


Yuflyma<sup>®</sup> is offered in an easy-to-use pre-filled pen device. The following steps will guide you to a safe and easy administration of Yuflyma®.

# Important information

- Use the pre-filled pen **only if** your healthcare provider has trained you in preparing and giving the injection.
- Ask your healthcare provider how often you will need to give the injection.
- **Do not** shake the pre-filled pen at any time.
- **Do not** remove the cap until you are ready to inject .
- **Do not** share the pre-filled pen with anyone.
- · Only use each pre-filled pen for one injection.

# Prepare for the injection

### **GATHER THE SUPPLIES**

- Prepare a clean, flat, and well-lit surface such as a table.
- · Remove the pre-filled pen from the carton stored in your refrigerator.
- · Items needed for injection: Pen, Alcohol swab, Cotton ball or gauze\*, Adhesive bandage\*, Sharps disposal container\*
- \* Items not included in the carton.

# Give the injection

### Step 1

### **REMOVE THE CAP**



- · Hold the pen by the injector body with the cap on top.
- Pull the cap straight off.
- \* **Do not** remove the cap until you are ready to inject.
- \* **Do not** touch the needle or needle cover.
- \* Do not recap the pen. Dispose of the cap immediately into the sharps disposal container.

### INSPECT THE PEN AND THE MEDICINE

- · Check the correct medicine and dosage.
- · Check the expiration date on the label of the pen.
- · Look through the window and make sure the liquid is clear, colorless to pale brown and free of particles.
- \* Do not use the pen if it has been cracked or is visibly damaged.
- \* **Do not** use the pen if the liquid is discolored, cloudy, or contains particles.
- \*It is normal for air bubbles to be seen in the liquid.

# **WAIT 15 TO 30 MINUTES**

- Leave the pen at room temperature (20°C to 25°C) for 15 to 30 minutes to let it warm up.
- \* Do not warm the pen using heat sources.

### Step 2



## **PLACE THE PEN**

- · Hold the pen so that you can see the window.
- · Without pinching or stretching the skin, place the pen over the injection site at a 90-degree angle.



# **GIVE THE INJECTION**

- Press the pen **firmly** against the skin.
- When the injection starts you will hear the 1<sup>st</sup> loud "click" and the blue plunger rod will begin to fill the window.
- Keep holing the pen and listen for the 2<sup>nd</sup> loud "click".
- After the 2<sup>nd</sup> loud "click," continue to hold the pen and count slowly to 5.
- \* **Do not** change the position of the pen after the injection has started.

# **CHOOSE AN INJECTION SITE**

- Select an injection site.
- · Possible injection sites:
- Abdomen, except for the 5cm around the belly button(navel) Outer area of the upper arms, ONLY if given by a caregiver
- \* **Do not** inject into skin that is within 5cm of your belly button (navel) or is tender, damaged, bruised, or scarred.
- = Caregiver ONLY
- Self-injection
- Rotate the injection site each time you give an injection.
- Each new injection site should be at least 3cm away from the previous site.



### **REMOVE THE PEN**

- Make sure that the blue plunger rod with the grey top has filled the window completely.
- · Remove the pen from your skin.
- Gently press a cotton ball or gauze over the injection site.
  - \* Do not reuse the pen.
- \* **Do not** rub the injection site.
- \* If the window has not turned completely blue, this means you have not received a full dose. Call your healthcare provider immediately.



# **WASH YOUR HANDS AND CLEAN THE INJECTION SITE**

- · Wash your hands with soap and water and dry them fully.
- Clean the injection site with an alcohol swab.
- Let the skin dry before injecting.
  - \* **Do not** blow or touch the injection site.

# After the injection



### **DISPOSE OF THE PEN**

- Throw away the used pen in a special sharps disposal container immediately after use.
- · Alcohol pads and packaging may be put in your household waste.
- \* Do not recap the pen.
- \* Keep the pen and sharps disposal container away from children.
